DONKEY TRADE BETWEEN GHANA AND BURKINA FASO IN YELIWONGO MARKET

- The donkey trade between Ghana and Burkina Faso is at Yeliwongo market in Burkina Faso
- The Yeliwogo Market is every three days
- Other animals in the market are small ruminants, cattle, fowls and general goods
- Many routes for movement of donkeys from Yeliwongo market into Ghana - Yua-Sirigu-Kandiga-Vea route used for this study

BOLGATANGA DONKEY MARKET AND BUTCHERS

- Bolgatanga donkey market (BDM) is one of the destination centres for donkeys from Yeliwongo
- Donkeys on hoof move through an approved route to BDM
- Butchers buy from BDM to slaughter within Bolgatanga municipality
- Butchers buy from BDM to far away as to Walewale by using vehicles
- Bolgatanga donkey market is every three days
- Skin of the donkey is the value for donkey slaughter in the municipality
- Meat from slaughtered donkeys sold locally and sent to other places





DONKEY SLAUGHTER POINTS IN BOLGATANGA AND NAVRONGO MUNICIPALITIES

- Many dotted slaughter points
- Slaughter between 5-20 donkeys per day
- Skins of slaughter donkeys dressed, and dried and sold as the highest price
- Donkey meat is smoked, using fuel wood
- Much firewood/fuel wood used in smoking donkey meat, causing environmental issues
- Indiscriminate slaughter of donkeys-including pregnant and weak ones

THE IMPACT OF DONKEY SKIN TRADE THROUGH SLAUGHTER ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT COMMUNITIES

- Less donkeys for draught power and transport services
- Less availability of donkey manure for crop production
- High cost of farm production tractors instead of donkeys
- Soil degradation with deep ploughing with tractors instead of donkeys
- Less visibility of donkey in livestock production
